Spring Break Camp

March 14-17 (9am-12p.m.)

This camp is designed to provide instruction in all aspects of the game. Participants will receive instruction in hitting, defense, pitching/catching, base running, and strategy. Summer Camp Descriptions

Specialty camps

These camps are broken into three sessions each day: hitting, defense/pitching/catching, and scrimmaging. Participants can sign up for one or multiple sessions – there is a discount for signing up for all three sessions. During each session, instruction will only be provided in the specified area. Ages 6-18

Skills and Scrimmaging Camp

These camps are designed to provide instruction in all aspects of the game. Participants will receive instruction in hitting, defense, pitching/catching, base running, and strategy.
